



COVID Outbreak Management Measures 30th Nov 2021/ Reviewed Jan22

Bubbles

The children will be kept in two bubbles whilst indoors to limit mixing:

EYFS / KS1 Bubble

KS2 Bubble

This will include lunchtimes when children will sit in their bubbles.

Children will be allowed to mix whilst playing outside.

Adults can move between bubbles.

Face Coverings

Adults will wear face coverings in communal areas around school. They may also choose to wear them in class. This is personal choice and the school supports their individual decision.

Moving around school

Children should be supervised when moving around school to avoid mixing.

Lining up and start and end of the day

We shouldn't need to reintroduce staggered starts however KS2 children will need to wait on the yard slightly longer at the start of the day and at the end of breaks whilst KS1 are brought in to avoid mixing in corridors. SLT to monitor this and adjustments will be made if necessary.

Testing

Staff will test at least 3 times a week using LFT tests at home to ensure they are COVID free.

Visitors to School

Visitors to school will be kept to a minimum. Essential visitors only.

Wraparound

Wraparound will continue as normal but children will sit or work in their separate bubbles as much as possible.

Assemblies

No whole school assemblies these will be delivered online via Teams.
